

GUIDE TO CONNECTED OBJECTS

To help your patients connect their devices to myDiabby Healthcare





This login guide provides information on how to connect to the various devices that are compatible with myDiabby Healthcare.

This guide is intended for healthcare professionals only. Please refer to the instructions for use for all information on using myDiabby Healthcare*.

*The manual is available for download and consultation on the myDiabby Healthcare platform.

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NB : These login guides work in the same way for the DT1, DT2 and Gestational Diabetes patient accounts

CAPILLARY BLOOD GLUCOSE METERS







For patients being monitored for gestational diabetes, it should be noted that once the blood sugar result appears on the myDiabby application, it must be associated with a time of day. To do this, CHECK or VERIFY the time of day so that the result is placed in the right place in the logbook.







The Fora Diamond Mini blood glucose meter connects directly via Bluetooth to the myDiabby application.

When you link your blood glucose meter to the myDiabby application, the date and time are automatically set on the meter based on the date and time on the phone.

- 5 The meter appears on the screen. Click on **"Add"**.

Your meter is now linked to your myDiabby application!

- **Test your blood sugar level** with the meter as usual.
- 2 When the blood sugar result is shown on the meter's screen, the Bluetooth symbol indicates that the meter is ready to send the result to the myDiabby application.
- 3 Make sure that Bluetooth is enabled on the smartphone, and open the myDiabby application, next to the meter still on.
- 4 The blood sugar result is automatically sent to the myDiabby application!

If you need to change the meal or time of day for this blood sugar level, you can click on it and enter the relevant information.

Linking the meter with the myDiabby application

- Download the 2 applications myDiabby and mylife to the phone. Log in to each of the 2 applications. The mylife application collects data from the Ypsopump insulin pump. Mylife will then automatically send the data to myDiabby Healthcare, which is the application that connects you with your healthcare team.
- 2 Connect the Unio Neva blood glucose meter to the mylife app via Bluetooth by following the meter guide.
- 3 Log in to the myDiabby application and open the "My connected objects" tab
- 4 Select "Connect my capillary blood glucose meter", then "MYLIFE Unio". Click on the "Connect my health application" button

Pairing of the meter

- And time to use connectivity with the myDiabby application.
- Enable Bluetooth on the smartphone

- **Open the myDiabby application** near the meter. 3 (Make sure Bluetooth is enaled on the smartphone).

Pairing of the meter

- Analytic Make sure the meter is set to the correct date and time to use connectivity with the myDiabby application.
- Write down the serial number of the Bluetooth adapter on a piece of paper
- 2 Enable Bluetooth on the smartphone
- Log in to the myDiabby application and open the "My connected objects" tab
- 4 Select "Connect my capillary blood glucose meter", then select your meter from the list
- 5 Click on the "Connect my meter" button
- 6 Connect the Bluetooth adapter to the Accu-Chek Mobile blood glucose meter
- 7 Turn on the Bluetooth adapter by pressing the side button. This turns on the meter and puts it in "pairing mode", and the adapter flashes green.





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- 8 On the myDiabby application, click on the "Find my meter" button
- 9 Enter the 6-digit serial number of the adapter (which you have written down) on the application and confirm.
- 10 The meter appears on the screen. Click on "Add".

Your meter is now linked to your myDiabby application!

Daily use

- **Test your blood sugar level** with the meter as usual.
- 2 Once the blood sugar result appears on the meter screen, **remove the strip** from the meter.
- **3 Open the myDiabby application** near the meter. (Make sure Bluetooth is enaled on the smartphone).
- 4 The blood sugar result is automatically sent to the myDiabby application!









NFC connection

Data transfer is done using the NFC antenna by bringing the meter close to your smartphone.



Make sure the meter is set to the correct date and time to use connectivity with the myDiabby application.



Enable NFC on your smartphone (in the settings) on some smartphones, NFC is enabled by default and cannot be disabled

- 3 Log in to the myDiabby application and open the "My connected objects" tab
- 4 Select "Connect my capillary blood glucose meter", then select your meter from the list
- 5 Click on the "Connect my meter" button
- Activate NFC on the meter. To do this:
 1 Open the player's parameter menu: press the M (on/off) and ▲ buttons simultaneously for 4 seconds
 - 2 Press the 🔽 button, an N will flash
 - 3 Press the **M button**, "Off" appears
 - 4 Press the ☑ button, "On" appears
 - 5 Press the M button, "SET" appears, the NFC is activated on your player.
 - 6 Turn off the meter: press the M button for 3 seconds







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The search is underway:

- On Android, bring the meter close to your smartphone at the NFC spot.
- On iPhone, **bring your insulin pen close to the NFC spot**. Your iPhone will vibrate once the meter is detected and a confirmation will appear on the screen.

CONTINUOUS BLOOD GLUCOSE MONITORS









If you are using the FreeStyle LibreLink or LibreView application, go directly to step 3.

- Create a LibreView account here: www.libreview.com/auth/register
- 2 Upload data from your FreeStyle Libre player to your LibreView account using a computer and the yellow USB cable supplied with the player. For help downloading data to LibreView, go to : <u>pat.libreview.io/support</u>
- **3** Log in to the **myDiabby application** and open the **«My connected objects»** tab
- 4 Click on the tab **«My Connected Objects»** tab, then on **«I'm connecting a health application».**



5 Select the button **FreeStyle Libre**



- 6 Enter your FreeStyle LibreLink / LibreView account username and passwor Read the conditions of use, then click «Authorise» to accept data sharing.
- 7 This message appears on the screen and confirms that the LibreView account is connected to myDiabby Healthcare.

Click on «Back» to return to myDiabby Healthcare.



Your continuous glucose data are now shared on myDiabby Healthcare!



PLEASE NOTE

Regularly upload data from the FreeStyle Libre sensor to LibreView so that the medical team can see the results on myDiabby Healthcare.

>Once LibreView and myDiabby are connected, LibreView automatically sends continuous glucose data to myDiabby Healthcare as soon as it becomes available. This may cause a delay of a few minutes between loading the data onto LibreView and displaying it on myDiabby Healthcare.

To share data from a Dexcom G6 or One monitor, you need to use the **Dexcom Clarity** software:

1 - The monitor data is retrieved by the Dexcom Clarity software

2 - Dexcom Clarity automatically sends the results to the myDiabby account

THE STEPS

- Create a Dexcom Clarity account from this site: https://uam2.dexcom.com//index.html#/register
- 2 Download the Dexcom Clarity Uploader from this page: <u>https://clarity.dexcom.eu/?locale=fr-FR#/home-user-upload</u> Then upload the monitor data to Dexcom Clarity by following the instructions on the screen.
- **3** Log in to the myDiabby account from a computer OR the mobile application.
- 4 Click on the "My Connected Objects" tab and then on "Connect my continuous glucose monitor".







5 Choose the Dexcom button, then click on the "CONNECT MY HEALTH APPLICATION" button

6 Enter your Dexcom account login details and password. Read the terms and conditions of use, then enter your name and click "Allow" to accept.

- This message appears on the screen and confirms that the Dexcom account is connected to myDiabby. Click on "Back" to return to myDiabby.
 - Continuous blood glucose data is now shared on myDiabby!

PLEASE NOTE

Upload the Dexcom meter data to Dexcom Clarity regularly so that the healthcare team can see the results on myDiabby. >> Once Dexcom and myDiabby are connected, Dexcom automatically sends data to myDiabby once an hour.

The data displayed is 3 hours behind the last available data.

> If you are using a Dexcom G6 in combination with the t:slim X2 Tandem Insulin Pump, you only need to upload the pump to myDiabby for the Tandem Pump + G6 monitor data to appear on myDiabby.

Method 1 : Sharing Omnipod on myDiabby via computer

To retrieve the data from the Omnipod, it must be uploaded using the myDiabby Uploader software.



MyDiabby Uploader is a small software program that you can install on your computer to upload data from blood glucose meters, blood glucose monitors and insulin pumps to your myDiabby Healthcare account.

Methode 2: Sharing pump data with the myDiabby application with a phone



Equipment needed

The Android smartphone on which the **mvDiabbv** The Omnipod PDM. application has been downloaded, and patient account logged in. The Omnipod PDM An adapter to connect a USB cable to the smartphone. USB cable.

Please note: The myDiabby team provides adapters free of charge to medical teams for distribution to their patients as part of their care on myDiabby Healthcare.

How to proceed

- Connect in this order:
 - 1 the cable to the phone with the adapter
 - 2 the cable to the PDM
- 2 The PDM turns on and emits a beep. It is preparing the data for transfer. Please wait.
- The PDM emits 4 times 2 beeps. 3 It is ready to transfer data to the phone.



4 Unlock the smartphone screen. Launch the myDiabby application and data sharing is initiated. The cable symbol flashes and a loading bar appears during data sharing. Please wait.

Caution:

Do not disconnect the cable from the meter or phone during sharing data. If there is a lot of data to share, the transfer may take several minutes.

The pump data is displayed on myDiabby! You can now disconnect the phone and the PDM.

THINGS TO CHECK IF YOU CAN'T MAKE THE TRANSFER

- Check when you open the myDiabby application that you are logged in to your account: if you are logged in, you will arrive on the dashboard. If you are not logged in, you need to enter your email and password.
- Be sure to connect the phone first, then the meter second.
- When you connect the meter, it should turn on and indicate "Connected to computer".
- If the connections move a little, be careful not to touch anything during the transfer.



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MYLIFE YPSOPUMP

To share data from the Unio Neva meter on myDiabby Healthcare, you need to use the mylife App.

To retrieve the data from the Omnipod, it must be uploaded using the myDiabby Uploader software.



MyDiabby Uploader is a small software program that you can install on your computer to upload data from blood glucose meters, blood glucose monitors and insulin pumps to your myDiabby Healthcare account.

1 - Before starting, you must have:

- Created your myDiabby account
- A pump (Medtronic 630G, 640G, 670G, 523, 723, Veo or 530G)
- A Contour Next Link blood glucose meter (for 523, 723, Veo and 530G pumps) OR a Contour Next Link 2.4 blood glucose meter (for 630G, 640G, 670G pumps)

- 3 If the insulin pump and Contour Next Link 2.4 meter are connected, check the box "The meter and pump are linked".

If the insulin pump and the Contour Next Link 2.4 meter are not connected, uncheck the box "The meter and the pump are linked" and enter the pump serial number (on the back of the pump)

- 4 Connect the Contour Next Link 2.4 reader to a USB port on the computer.
- 5 Select the duration of the data to be uploaded, then click on "Send".
- 6 Your data uploads to the computer. If the pump was not connected to the meter, you will need to confirm the connection on the pump to start the upload.
- At the end of the upload, click on "View Data" to go to the myDiabby online platform and see all your results.





Sharing Tandem t:slim X2™ on myDiabby via computer

- The USB cable for the Tandem t:slim x2 pump

Connect the TouchCare Nano or 300 pump to the EasyPatch application via Bluetooth, or upload your PDM data to the EasyTouch application, following the insulin pump guide.

The EasyPatch application allows the pump to be controlled using the smartphone, with the data automatically uploaded to the **Medtrum cloud**. The data available on the Medtrum cloud will then be automatically sent to myDiabby Healthcare, which is the application that provides a link with the medical team.

- **2** Log in to your myDiabby Healthcare account from a computer OR the myDiabby mobile application.
- 3 Click on the tab «My Connected Objects» tab, then on «I'm connecting a health application».



4 Select the button Medtrum



5 Enter your EasyPatch / EasyTouch account username and password. Read the terms of use, tick the acceptance box, enter your name in the dedicated field and click «Authorise» to accept data sharing.

6 This message appears on the screen and confirms that the Medtrum cloud account is connected to myDiabby Healthcare. Click on «Back» to return to myDiabby Healthcare.



Your insulin pump data are now shared on myDiabby Healthcare!



PLEASE NOTE

Regularly check that the data from your TouchCare insulin pump is visible on the Medtrum cloud so that the medical team can see the results on myDiabby Healthcare.

> Data download is automatic on the EasyPatch application and manual on the EasyTouch application.

> Once the Medtrum cloud account and myDiabby Healthcare are connected, the Medtrum cloud automatically uploads streaming pump data to myDiabby Healthcare as it becomes available. There may be a delay of a few minutes between the data being uploaded to the Medtrum cloud and being displayed on myDiabby Healthcare.

NFC connection

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Data transfer is done using the NFC antenna by bringing the insulin pen close to your smartphone.

Enable NFC on your smartphone (in the settings) 1 - on some smartphones, NFC is enabled by default and cannot be disabled

Log in to the myDiabby application and open

Select "Novo Nordisk NovoPen® 6/NovoPen

Echo® Plus Insulin Pen", then click on

"Connect my device".

Select "Connect an insulin pen connect system".

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- 6 Select your pen and confirm your selection.
- 7 Fill in your data:

• The time associated with the injection (breakfast, lunch, snack, dinner)

• The type of insulin injected • If it is a priming or airshot, you can disregard the dose by clicking on «Delete airshot»

8 Confirm. The dose is added to your record, you can view it from your Dashboard or your logbook on the myDiabby application!

Daily use

- Login to the myDiabby application
- 2 open the "My connected objects" tab
- 3 At the pen you have connected, press "Synchronize".
- 4 Move your insulin pen towards the NFC antenna of your smartphone until you feel a vibration or hear a confirmation sound
- 5 Then **complete the data** retrieved to view it in your logbook.
